# 1. WHAT SIN IS

Romans 6:23

Sin is doing what I want as opposed to what God wants. Sin is an attitude of rebellion. Lying, cheating, etc. are the result or fruit of such rebellion.

Before you received Christ, sin prevented you from having a
relationship with God. Read Ephesians 2: 1-5
What was your spiritual condition? (v.1)
Who controlled your life? (v.2)
What were you by nature? (v.3)
Now that you have received Christ, by God's mercy, what have you become? (v. 4, 5)
What are the results of sin in our lives? Read and discuss these verses:

Romans 2:8, 9 Psalm 66:18 John 8:34

### 2. WHY WE SIN

God has given us a free will to obey Him or to disobey Him. (Romans 6:12, 13). As Christians, sin inhibits fellowship with God. It takes time to grow and learn to think as God thinks. Our minds need to be renewed. (Romans 12:1, 2)

Temptation and sin are common to all of us. What are three primary areas of temptation?

Read Romans 6:1, 2. As Christians why should we not continue to sin?					

# 3. JESUS CHRIST IS GOD'S REMEDY FOR SIN

The purpose of Christ's death was:

- a. to bring us to God
- b. to pay for our sins (1 Peter 3:18)

Read the following passage:

"You were dead in sin and your sinful desires were not yet cut away. Then He gave you a share in the very life of Christ, for He forgave <u>all</u> your sin, and blotted out the charges proved against you, the list of His commandments which you had not obeyed. He took this list of sins and destroyed it by nailing it to Christ's cross."

(Colossians 2:13, 14, Living Bible)

For how many of your sins did Christ die?
Colossians 2:13, 14 (above)
"All" means "All" - past, present and future sins. Now that you have received Christ you are completely forgiven. How will knowing that you are forgiven affect your life?
4. HOW TO APPLY GOD'S REMEDY FOR SIN
Remember, that you have been totally forgiven because of Jesus Christ's death on the cross for you, but to continue to experience fellowship with God daily, you need to confess any known sins.
If we confess our sins, what will Christ do?
1 John 1:9
Confess means to agree with God about your sin.
a. <b>Agree</b> that it is <u>sin</u> .
b. Thank God that He has already provided forgiveness.
c. Change your wrong attitudes. (Repentance)

- d. Allow  ${f God}$  to empower you to change your actions.
- e. **Claim** your forgiveness as fact by faith and live a life free from guilt.

As you confess your sins and claim God's forgiveness, you will enjoy a life of victory over sin.
